

## **Storytelling :The Tiger who came to tea: food vocabulary**

Language objectives: **food vocabulary and past tenses ate, drank, was**

**Stages:** Children work in groups of three for the storytelling. Before the story, children make a pocketbook each. Give each group of three the food pictures. Cut the pictures into three columns and each child cuts up their pictures in one column.

Tell the story and children stick the pictures one by one onto different pages of their pocket book. Children cut another column of their pictures. Repeat the story and children stick further pictures in their book. Children then take it in turns to tell the story to each other so the last of the pictures can be stuck in alone.
