**ITALY**

In Italy, Christmas runs from December 8th (the Feast of the Immaculate Conception) to January 6th (the Epiphany). On December 8th many Italian families decorate their home and trees.

One of the most famous Italian Christmas traditions is the presepe or nativity scene. It represents the birth of Jesus and the first one was made in Italy by St. Francis of Assisi in 1223. Presepe decorate churches, squares and houses.



**ITALY**

During the Christmas time, houses, streets, squares are decorated with colorful lights, with Christmas trees and ornaments such as Christmas balls, wreaths (for example, made of holly), candles and colored ribbons.



The final festive of Christmas is the arrival of La Befana. On the eve of Epiphany, January 5th, children leave their socks out to be filled with candy, fruits and little presents. Naughty children will find a lump of coal in their socks! La Befana is an old woman riding a broom and delivers gift while children are asleep.

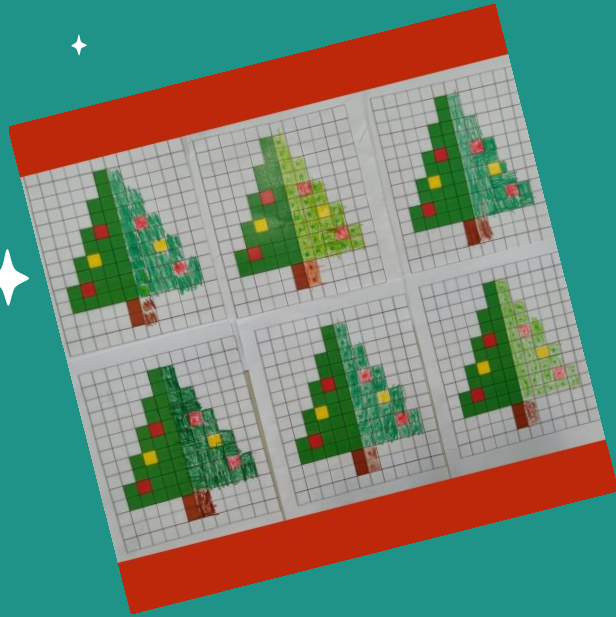

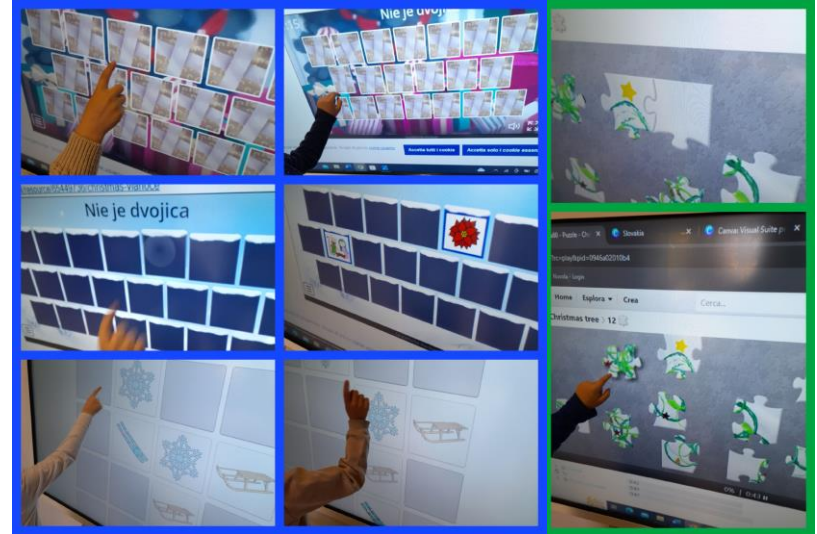


# Symmetric Coding Christmas Tree
